Equipment Delivery to Substation

Dear Neighbors,

This notice is being sent as a courtesy to update you that National Grid continues to progress on efforts to rebuild the substation located at 83 Boulevard Street, Lowell, Massachusetts. As you know we have been working to upgrade and install new equipment at the site in an effort to provide safe, reliable electricity for the region.

As a next step, on <u>Thursday, February 8th and Friday, February 9th</u> there will be several deliveries of large electrical equipment to the site.

- Where We Will Be Working: The deliveries will access the construction site by traveling the length of Boulevard Street from Varnum Avenue to the construction site at 83 Boulevard Street. The deliveries will require oversized load trucks with support vehicles and a police escort. There will also be a crane needed onsite to unload the equipment.
- Anticipated Delivery Time and Impacts: Several large deliveries will be staged at a nearby parking lot location and dispatched to the site and unloaded one at a time. We are working with our vendor to avoid or minimize impacting school bus pick-up and morning/evening commutes. Access to and from private property and driveways will be maintained during the delivery, but vehicles traveling up or down Boulevard Street during this time may have to safely pull off to the side of the road or into a driveway if they encounter a police detail or escort vehicle. Please do not park your vehicle on the roadway during daytime hours on Thursday and Friday (February 8th and February 9th).
