

Lawrence #1 D-Substation Rebuild and D-Line Upgrades

Lawrence, MA | Summer 2024

The Lawrence #1 substation, constructed in 1944, requires a rebuild due to its deteriorating condition and limited capacity. To address these issues and to meet growing electric demand, the current substation will be retired, and a new substation will be built adjacent to it. To incorporate the new substation, upgrades are required to much of the existing overhead infrastructure (poles and wires) including new underground infrastructure.

Project details:

The Lawrence #1 D-Substation Rebuild and D-Line Upgrades project includes the retirement and replacement of the existing substation accompanied with upgrades to existing overhead infrastructure. The project will improve electrical reliability in Lawrence, ensuring enhanced service and operational efficiency.

What to expect during construction:

- **Residents can anticipate increased activity** within the substation area and throughout South Lawrence. This includes increased personnel presence, equipment utilization, and material deliveries going in and out of the substation as well as the neighboring streets.
- **Restoration** of any disturbed roadway/sidewalk areas.
