The Lawrence #2 substation, an indoor substation, requires a rebuild to strengthen the electric system to more reliably serve our customers in your area. The current substation will be retired, and a new substation will be built adjacent to it. The new substation will be integrated via conduit connecting to existing underground infrastructure on Common Street in Lawrence.

Project details:

The Lawrence #2 Substation Rebuild and D-Line Upgrades project includes the retirement, replacement, and removal of the existing substation. The new equipment will be installed in an adjacent lot accompanied by a new perimeter fence. The project will improve electrical reliability in Lawrence, ensuring enhanced service and operational efficiency.

What to expect during construction:

- Increased activity within the substation area at the corner of Common Street and Amesbury Street in Lawrence. This includes increased personnel presence, equipment utilization, and deliveries.
- Construction activities such as excavation and soil removal, micropile and foundation installation, and material deliveries going in and out of the substation.
- Restoration of any disturbed roadway/sidewalk areas.
