Lawrence #2 Substation Rebuild

Construction Activities in Lawrence

Dear Neighbor,

As you may be aware, National Grid is working on improvements to strengthen our electric distribution systems to more reliably serve our customers in your area. The upgrades include rebuilding the existing electric substation on National Grid property at the corner of Common Street and Amesbury Street as well as upgrading the connected underground distribution lines. The existing Lawrence #2 substation is an indoor substation that has been in operation since the late 1920's. Much of the equipment is in need of replacement to support future electrical needs and to continue serving thousands of customers.

As an update to the start of construction notice delivered in August 2024, work to rebuild the Lawrence #2 substation is planned to begin **the week of October 21**. You can expect increased activity at the substation as crews perform equipment mobilization and site preparations. In the coming weeks, work activities will include excavation and soil removal, micropile and foundation installation, and deliveries to the substation. Those in close proximity to the substation may experience construction noise and vibrations as a result of some work activities

During these activities there will be an increase of vehicles and team members within the area. Our employees, contractors, and consultants are expected to wear their required personal protection equipment (PPE), including hard hats, high visibility vests and photo ID's.

To ensure the safety of crews performing the work, it may be necessary to limit the roadway to through traffic. Residential traffic is permitted, and signs will be placed in work areas to alert motorists. Police details will be near the work site to direct any traffic.

Work will occur primarily between the hours of 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Monday through Thursday. Some work may be approved on Fridays or the weekends in extenuating circumstances. Truck traffic will use caution while on the streets in your area. **There are no scheduled power interruptions as a result of these operations**.
