Upcoming Work: Vegetation Clearing Along National Grid's Rights of Way | Fall 2024

To deliver a more resilient energy network for customers like you, National Grid is building a smarter, stronger, cleaner energy grid that will positively impact our communities today and for generations to come.

Our work, taking place in neighborhoods like yours across Upstate New York, is called the **Upstate Upgrade**. It involves more than 70 projects through 2030 that will transform the transmission grid to meet growing demand for electricity while generating thousands of new jobs and more than a billion dollars in economic growth across the region.

Among the 70 transmission projects is one in your community, the North Watertown-Indian River Project. It involves building a new 115kV transmission line, a new substation, and rebuilding an existing substation in Jefferson County. **We are writing you to inform you of upcoming vegetation clearing along our rights of way in the region. Vegetation Clearing Along Our Rights of Way

North Watertown-Indian River

Vegetation clearing is scheduled to **begin in November 2024 and continue until spring 2025** along the new 9.5-mile transmission line right of way. Trees and brush within National Grid's right of way will be removed to prepare for the new transmission line and related construction access. Trees adjacent to the right of way that could damage the line (known as danger trees) will also be removed.

Crews will typically work Monday – Saturday from 7 AM – 7 PM. For your safety, please stay away from construction areas and equipment. If you have questions or concerns, please contact us via phone or email.
