PL-E18 Pipeline ILI Enable (Mohawk River and I890 HDD)
Project Update | January 2025

National Grid's commitment to our customers and communities begins by providing safe and reliable service. To that end, National Grid will be making improvements to our infrastructure so it can continue to safely and reliably supply the customers in Schenectady and Saratoga Counties with natural gas.

Project Description

We are about to begin a natural gas infrastructure improvement project in your area which will replace approximately 1.1 miles of natural gas transmission pipeline (Pipeline E18) between the Towns of Glenville and Rotterdam in Schenectady County. The existing pipeline will be decommissioned and abandoned in place after installation of the new pipeline. Replacing this section of Pipeline E18 will allow National Grid to proactively increase the long-term reliability of its assets and will help enable future inline inspections of the pipe. The ability to perform inline inspections is beneficial because it allows for the performance of a more thorough inspection using advanced technology.

What activities will occur?

The project will be performed under Article VII of the New York State Public Service Law. After the project is approved, National Grid and our approved contractors will be in your area performing work necessary to construct the pipeline, including marking utilities, survey work, necessary vegetation clearing, and eventually construction.

How will the work affect me?

The impacts to our customers and neighbors will be minimal. The preparatory work will be done in the Spring of 2026, with construction following. Most of the construction will be underground and not visible to the general public.

What will construction impacts be?

The construction impacts will be minimal. Our team will work with community members to notify them of upcoming activities. Please contact us if you would like to discuss timelines related to your location.
