Dear Neighbor:

This letter is to inform you that National Grid crews and contractors are preparing for the construction of a new electric substation at 132 State Route 28 in Raquette Lake, NY. Our current substation — located on the corner of State Route 28 and County Road 2 — will be replaced with a new substation across the road, and its sole purpose is to better serve our customers.

Beginning the week of December 23, 2024 until March 2025, crews will begin the civil construction work on the new substation. During this time, you may see trees and stumps being removed and stone brought to the site. This will be followed by the pouring and installation of concrete foundations for the substation equipment, which will arrive to the site in Spring 2025.

Between April and May 2025, our overhead line crews will upgrade the distribution and subtransmission structures within the substation site as well as the structures along State Route 28. You may experience occasional traffic delays along State Route 28 during this time.

Between June and August 2025, crews will complete a cutover from the existing substation to the new substation. Raquette Lake customers may experience a short, temporary outage while this cutover is conducted. We will provide advance notice of when the outage will occur.

Finally, following energization of the new substation, the existing substation will be retired and torn down, and the site will be returned to grass.
