Check your eligibility for [income-based offers](#)

STEP

You may be eligible for income-based offers which include enhanced rebates or no-cost and/or discounted energy efficiency services based on your household income.

Schedule your no-cost [Home Energy Assessment](#)

STEP

A well-insulated home is key to maximizing the efficiency of your new heat pump. Our expert Energy Specialists will evaluate your home's insulation and provide personalized energy-efficiency recommendations.

Install recommended weatherization

STEP

Heat pumps installed in a properly weatherized home can dramatically improve comfort. A tighter, more insulated home will not only save money on operating costs and reduce carbon emissions throughout the year—it may also allow you to install smaller, less expensive equipment.

Partial home rebates: If you are installing a partial home heat pump, please consider weatherizing your home. If you do so prior to or up to six months after installing your heat pump system, you could be eligible for a \$500 bonus.

Whole home rebates: To be eligible for a whole home rebate, demonstration of [sufficient weatherization](#) is required.

Contractors in our Heat Pump Installer Network (HPIN) are ready to assist you in selecting the perfect qualifying heat pump for your home. We recommend getting at least 3 quotes from HPIN contractors before scheduling your installation.
